



The Law of Divine Oneness

The Divine Oneness can be found at the very foundation of every belief system in the world. It is something that the ancient people knew, without question, and somehow became lost in the very hurried and ego-centric lifestyles of the Western world.

- *In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth... Genesis 1:1*
- *Indra slew the dragon, freeing the rivers, the cows, the dawn...Vedic texts*
- *Skywoman threw dust into the air creating the stars... Iroquois Legend*

In each of these creation tellings, the being known as God, Creator, or one within the pantheon beliefs is the first instance of sentient life or consciousness.

Sentient: To be self-aware or able to perceive and feel things.

We don't know when that occurred, therefore the Divine, as you know it, has always been.

In the early twentieth century, scientists discovered what they now refer to as the zero-point energy field. It is within this field that theoretically all things are connected. Why theoretically? Although, scientists are aware of the zero-point energy field, the substance of that field is so small that we currently lack the technology to see it at its smallest point. However, that does not negate its existence.

Human beings, like all other living beings and the universe itself, are made up of energy particles. We are a pattern of energy, manifesting in our current physical form, yet remaining connected to everyone and everything else.

There are 12 Universal Laws that govern the universe. However, only the Law of Divine Oneness governs the remaining eleven laws. Without the base fabric of the oneness, no other law would be functional or necessary. The Divine Oneness is the one rule to rule them all, or the very fabric that holds the universe together, and all things are a part of the oneness.

NOTE: Within these laws exists the Law of Attraction, made popular in the 20th Century by Rhonda Byrne's book, *The Secret* (Byrne, 2006). Although the book itself is fictional in nature, it is based on the 12 Laws of the Universe, which are, in fact, laws of physics. 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In order to understand the Law of Divine Oneness, we must first understand divinity itself.

The word “Divine” means *‘of, from, or like God’*, when used as an adjective, such as used in The Law of Divine Oneness; divine being the adjective or descriptor of the word Oneness.

As a noun, the word “Divine” means *‘providence or God’*. Providence means *‘God or Nature as providing protective or spiritual care’*.

Oneness means exactly what it implies: *the fact or state of being unified or whole though comprised of two or more parts*.

Now ask yourself: Could it be true that: *Two or more parts that comprise a state of being as unified whole is of, from, or like God, and as such finds itself under the protective or spiritual care of the same whole?*

Take time to listen to your inner-self. Is it true for you?

In your journal, consider the following things:

- The Law of Divine Oneness comprises all things, even itself, as a unified whole.
- Could you be one of those parts, infinitely and finitely part of the greater zero-point energy field?
- Have you experienced, or is it possible to experience, divine protection and provision from the greater whole?
